



Explanation of MACS 405 Revisions

The MACS 405 is a component of the MACS 400-3 that is also used daily as a stand-alone document. The following changes were made to this revised version.

- The number of “Types” was expanded from 4 to 7 to reflect the number of “Types” recognized by FIRESCOPE.
- The form was modified to better clarify Type vs. Kind
- “Other” has been added to list of “Kinds”. Other can be used for REMS, Haz Mat, or any other resource and the Kind can be documented in the comments section.
- The MACS 405 (July 1, 2009) currently on the website, has “Available Single Resource” listed twice. This has been revised.
- ***If resource availability changes due to deployment, submit a new Resource Status Report. (This sentence was added to assist agencies in conveying that they could staff a Type 1/2 or a Type 3 or a Type 6, but not all.) The addition of this sentence has been viewed as a good solution by the end users.
